Based on the Southside of Chicago since 1988, Dr. Yetta G. McCollum is a Diplomate of the American Board of Periodontology. Dr. McCollum graduated from Howard University in 1983 with a degree in Biology and proceeded to earn her Doctor of Dental Surgery from Howard University's College of Dentistry in 1985. After deciding to professionally concentrate in periodontics, Dr. McCollum went on to complete the Master of Science program at Northwestern University Dental School, with a Certificate of Periodontics in 1990. Since then, Dr. McCollum has been diligent in advancing her education in the field of periodontics with a focus on the perio-systemic link. Since 2009, Dr. McCollum has been offering the Laser Assisted New Attachment Procedure (LANAP) as the initial treatment for the management of periodontitis. By working in a group practice setting, Dr. McCollum can stay in her preferred lane of helping patients maintain their natural dentition and improve their overall health.
