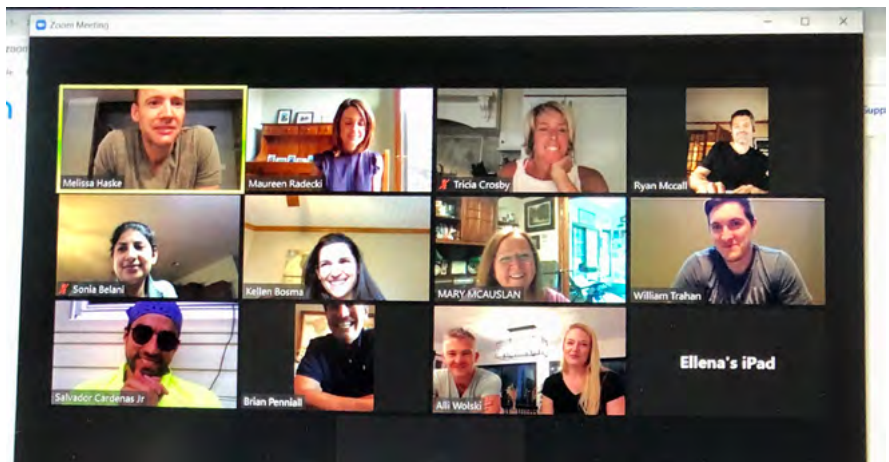

## Biologic Considerations in Implant Treatment Planning -- Is Titanium the answer?

**About the Presentation:** Today, conservation of teeth and preservation or regeneration of alveolar bone are the guiding principles of periodontal treatment. With the current advancements in technology and techniques, these should be also the guiding principles of dental implant therapy for both dentulous and edentulous patients. Template-style treatment plans that call for routine extraction of all teeth and replacement with implants often require severe reduction of the remaining alveolar bone to create restorative space for vertically large implant-supported prostheses. In patients that suffer from peri-implantitis, the lack of treatment alternatives due to previous severe bone reduction could lead to the patient becoming a dental cripple later in life. This presentation highlights the importance of a thorough analysis when developing a treatment plan, focusing on preservation of bone and natural dentition, providing biologic principles for implant therapy.

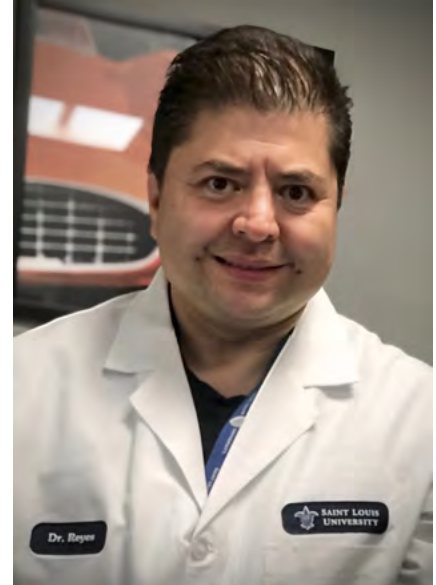
**Course Objective:** Participants will learn timing and staging considerations when treatment planning implants, which may aid in keeping alternatives in progressive high risk patients.
