Stephen MacLeod BDS, MBChB, FDSRCS, FRCS, FFSTRCS (ED), FACS is the Joseph A and Louise Ada Jarabak Professor of Surgery, Director, Division of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery and Dental Medicine, Program Director, Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery Residency and Vice-Chair for Professional Development at Loyola University Medical Center.

Stephen completed Dental, Medical and Surgical Training in Scotland, obtaining FDSRCS and FRCS Ed, followed by a Fellowship at the University of Louisville. He has served as chair of the Trauma Clinical Interest Group of the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons and as President of the Craniomaxillofacial Surgery Board of AONA. In this role he has been involved in development of courses that have been taught nationally and internationally. His major interests have been the management of maxillofacial trauma, faculty development, non-technical skills, clinical coaching and resiliency training.
