Monica Patadia, M.D.

Dr. Patadia is a professor in the Otolaryngology Department at Loyola University Medical Center. She is a graduate of Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine, where she remained for her internship in general surgery and residency in otolaryngology-head and neck surgery. She completed an additional year fellowship in advanced rhinology, allergy and facial plastic surgery at the Midwest Sinus Center/Rush University. She is a recipient of an American Rhinologist Society CORE Grant for her work with "Mechanisms of B Cell Recruitment in Chronic Rhinosinusitis with Nasal Polyps." Her clinical interests include facial plastic surgery, including Botox injections, facial fillers, nose jobs, eyelid surgery, and face lifts. Other interests include nasal obstruction due to chronic rhinosinusitis, especially nasal polyposis and allergic fungal rhinosinusitis, allergic rhinitis and functional obstruction including nasal valve collapse. She is certified by the American Board of Otolaryngology.
